Purpose of Predictive Algorithm

An "algorithm" is just a piece of computer code that makes a decision or recommendation of some kind.

> Algorithms create models to Predict (what is likely to happen!)

- Google (1.17 Billion users in December 2012)
 - What is the news and what to SEARCH for
- Amazon (270 Million accounts)
 - What to PURCHASE next
- Facebook (1.15 Billion users)
 - What is INTERESTING
- Netflix (60 million subscribers)
 - What MOVIES to watch
- OkCupid (12 Million users between 29-85 years old)
 - Who to **DATE**
- Pandora (8.2 Million paying subscribers)
 - What to LISTEN to





About Facebook



- Today, with 1.1 Billion users, Facebook users collectively spend 10 Billion minutes online!
- Facebook knows you better than your mother and certainly better than yourself!
 - Knows about your political views, where you live, how many credit cards you own, what job you hold, knows all your friends, AND



Facebook Algorithm Model

- FB's business model is based efficient use of USER's data
- Using the available data algorithms can predict your general personality

Facebook Algorithms



- Facebook has been using EdgeRank algorithm
 - Finding your old high-school friends & past co-workers
- Facebook introduced Digital Assistance Algorithm, M
 - Facebook intends to apply M to our Facebook Data to help us BUY better gifts, books, reserve tables at restaurants, watch better movies, and more pleasant music!
- Facebook's Facial Recognition Algorithm, FRA
 - Facebook's FRA picks out faces in your photos and if a face matches one you previously tagged in another album, Facebook may suggest that person's name for you!

Facebook Personalizing Algorithms

It's not just your imagination - there are a lot of old posts in your Facebook feed

In an experiment, nearly half of the posts displayed in the News Feed were made on previous days. And the majority of new posts weren't displayed at all.

Facebook's Emotional Manipulation Experiment!

- In 2013 Facebook in Conjunction with Cornell University ran an experiment:
 - Let's tweak the newsfeed algorithm for one week
 - 700,000 users were affected
 - Half observed more **positive** news, the rest observed more **negative** news

The half that saw more positive news posted more positive messages!


Google.....

- The only company's name that is associated with a verb (think?)
- The bulk of Google's revenue comes from its advertising service, Google AdWord



- Google processes over 40,000 search queries per second (3.5 billion/day)
- Every query has to travel on average 1,500 miles to a data center and back to return the answer to the user.

64.6% of people click on Google Ads when they are looking to buy an item online!

Google's Search Algorithm

$$PR(p_i; t+1) = \frac{1-d}{N} + d\sum_{p_j \in M(p_i)} \frac{PR(p_j; t)}{L(p_j)}$$

- Sophisticated algorithm listing the search results for your query
- It is this algorithm that determines which listing make it to the top!
 - Originally called PageRank
 - New versions are Panda, Penguin, Hummingbird, and Pigeon
 - Pigeon considers over 200 ranking factor!
- Contrary to popular belief Google ranking is NOT based on democratic process & popular rate!
- Google search is certainly pragmatic & it works but it is far from being neutral and does create some bias!

NewsRank Decides

.... Which News to See!

- Google News algorithm is based on a long list of factors including freshness, quality, popularity, locality, and expertise of source
- Does Fox News have more expertise on health reform than DemocracyNow?
- Two boats carrying about 500 migrants sank after leaving Libya on 27 August – Did this make it to the leading item in Google News?

Why Should I Even Care?

What is Wrong with Personalizing Everything?

- Personalized algorithms could isolate us from opposing views and new ideas
 - We can become **less tolerant**!
 - Some sociologists worry about a form of Social Control
- Personalized algorithms try to predict and show you the content you like
 - They operate based on what you tend to like
- Facebook and Google claim the personalization is for our benefit – They are mainly for advertisers!
 - Corrupt Personalization personalization is really serving a corporation at our expense! - Christian Sandvig

Algorithms Organize the Information



- In New York Time the gatekeeper is the Editor
- In Google the gatekeeper is PageRank/ NewsRank algorithms
